Provided by Registered Nurses with specialist qualifications in Child and Family Health

The first 2000 days, from conception to 5 years of age, is a vital time to support your child's development and help them get ready for school.

Child and Family Health services can help parents in this journey with children.

What does the Child and Family Health Service offer?

Our nurses work in partnership with families and offer support, guidance, and information on how to care safely for your child, including:

- · Well child health and development checks
- · Breastfeeding and infant feeding
- · Sleep, settling and coping with crying
- · Playing with your baby
- · Parent support groups
- · Your own wellbeing

All nursing services are free of charge to families.

Arranging your first child and family health check, after giving birth

The maternity unit where you give birth to your baby will send your details to the Child and Family Health service. A Child and Family Health Nurse will contact you to offer your child's first health and development check appointment.

If you need support before the nurse contacts you, please phone your local Child and Family Health Centre. (See list of centers over the page).

Blue Book - Your child's health record

Your child's Blue Book has details about each of the age-specific checks recommended for children.

With your agreement, Child and Family Health nurses, and other health professionals, will document your child's health and development check results in your child's Blue Book. This helps parents and health professionals to track children's growth, health, immunisations and development progress.



Child health and development checks

Child health and development checks are very important. They help you track how your child is growing and developing by looking at how they play, learn, speak, act, and move.



There are eight recommended health and development checks for children.

1 to 4 weeks	6 to 8 weeks
6 months	12 months
18 months	2 years
3 years	4 years

Parents and caregivers can make an appointment, at the nearest Child and Family Health Centre for all your child's checks.
